
B-3-8- Minutes of the meeting will be sent to each director within 2 weeks after the meeting. Also a proposed agenda should be made and mailed prior of following meeting.

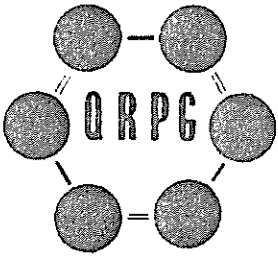
